

# Queer Library Erfurt - Terms of Use

## §1 General

1. The Queer Library Erfurt is run by the association „Trans Inter Aktiv Mitteldeutschland e.V.“. It is located in the premises of the Queer Centre Erfurt.
2. Everyone is entitled to use the library based on these regulations.
3. In principle the use of the library is free of charge.
4. In case of violation of these terms of use, the members of the association „Trans-Inter-Aktiv e.V.“ are entitled to suspend the person\*s from the library premises and to refuse the borrowing.
5. Discriminatory statements will not be tolerated in the library. Discriminatory statements include: transphobic, homophobic, and misogynistic statements. The present employees of „Trans-Inter-Aktiv e.V.“ have the authority to decide about the evaluation of the statement.

## §2 Lending

1. **For the lending of books and media** a contact possibility in the form of an email address or telephone number is required. **However it is up to you to choose a name for the contact form. It does not have to be supported by a valid personal identification document.**
2. **The loan period for books is two months.**
3. **The loan period for films and audio media is three weeks.**
4. There is no charge for exceeding the deadline of the loan period.
5. In case of interlibrary loan, the costs of delivery and return are to be paid by the borrower.

## §3 Possibilities of Use

1. The use of the media can take place on the premises of the library or by borrowing for the use outside the library.
2. The employees of Trans-Inter-Aktiv e.V. support the users in their search for literature by giving advice and information.
3. The media of the Queer Library Erfurt are to be treated with care. Damage to the media must be reported to the staff of Trans-Inter-Aktiv e.V..
4. In case of loss or substantial damage the user should replace the media. The form of replacement will be decided individually and in consultation with the staff of Trans-Inter-Aktiv e.V..
